CAFES

Bluestone Lane

27 Brattle St.

An Australian-inspired coffee shop designed to blend signature Melbourne & Sydney coastal café aesthetics. The two floor space touts an all-day menu with health focused options.

Blue Bottle

40 Bow St.

This Bow St. staple offers an array of classic coffee drinks & pastries, plus beans & brewing equipment.

Flour Bakery and Café

114 Mount Auburn St.

Founded by chef and Harvard grad Joanne Chang, Flour offers a full menu of fresh pastries, cakes, and tarts, plus lunch items like sandwiches, salads, and soups.

Life Alive Organic Cafe

765 Massachusetts Ave.

A friendly, funky, quick-serve spot for organic veggie/vegan wraps, salads & smoothies. This new addition to Harvard Square joins the original location just down the road in Central Square.

Tatte Bakery and Café

1288 Massachusetts Ave.

A two floor space with an open bakery and kitchen on the first floor and a coffee bar on the second floor. Tatte serves a full breakfast, lunch and dinner during the week, and brunch on the weekend.

Serves thoughtfully sourced American food in a subterranean, modern and comfortable space.

Cambridge Common

Changsho
