1L Spring Upper-level Elective Round

- All 1Ls must enroll in one, 2-4 credit elective during their spring semester.
- Students <u>must</u> preference between 6 and 12 courses during this registration round.
- When preferencing, all courses available to 1Ls will be shown. *However, you should only preference courses included in your section list.*
 - If you preference a course not included on your section list, you will not be enrolled and you will be wasting a bid.

Now that your preferences are submitted, what's next?

1. <u>Confirmation of Bids Email:</u>

- Sent to all students that submitted bids (approximately 1 hour after closing of bids).
- If you do not receive this email then we did not receive your bids.
 - In this case, <u>email</u> the Registrar's Office with a list of your preferences via <u>registrar@law.Harvard.edu</u>
- 2. The enrollment <u>algorithm</u> runs.
- **3**. Results are released in Helios by 5pm on the stated release date for that round.



Add/Drop & Waitlist Processing:

Add/drop begins once results are released for each round.

- Add/drop deadlines:
 - January Experiential Term: Wednesday December 4th at 11:59pm ET.
 - Spring Upper-level Elective: Friday, January 31st at 11:59pm ET.

Waitlist processing:

- Waitlists are processed in priority order.
- Students have 15-hours to accept waitlist offers.
- Waitlist processing will pause in early December for the fall exam period and will resume after winter break.
