### WHAT IS NDAB?

- The Non-Discrimination and Anti-Bullying (NDAB) Policies prohibit discrimination on the basis of protected categories: age, race, color, national origin, sex, genetic information, ancestry, religion, caste, creed, veteran status, disability, military service, sexual orientation, and political beliefs.
- NDAB also prohibits hostile and abusive behavior or power-based harassment; harmful interpersonal aggression by words or actions that humiliate, degrade, demean, intimidate, or threaten.
